Introduction

South Carolina State NFIRS Program offers free training to all fire service personnel so that data collection, incident reporting, and subsequent analysis are of the highest caliber. Whether you are an end user, an administrator, or a fire coordinator, there is a training available for you. End User Training

3.0 Hours

Learn how to navigate the modules of fire incident reports, the purpose of NFIRS, how to write a great narrative, and how to gather information regardless of the situation. This class is ideal for those new to NFIRS and a great refresher for experienced users.

Administrator Training (Administrator I)

4.0 Hours

Use your local data to solve your district's fire problem– and learn ways to get from “bad data” to “great data”! This class covers quality control, using web-tools, and communication from the field to the report-writing process. This class is recommended for individuals who oversee their department's fire incident reporting process and most advanced NFIRS users.

NFIRS Workshop

3.0-8.0 Hours

Each workshop is geared towards a different NFIRS topic. Departments who wish to host a workshop are welcome to pick any topic(s) they like, and an experienced NFIRS teacher will lead a presentation and any activities related to that topic.

DIY Training: Quick Training Modules

2-10 minutes for each (no credit)

Learn NFIRS in bite-size pieces at your own pace. New material is always being added, and immediate feedback on assessments make sure that you've learned the material.

DIY Training: Long-Term Lessons

Total 4-16 hours (no credit)
