MEMORANDUM

TO: South Carolina Explosive Storage Magazine Permit Holders
FROM: Ray Hoshall, Chief of Licensing and Permitting
DATE: November 30, 2016
SUBJECT: Application for 2017 Explosive Magazine Permits

As a reminder, the S.C. Explosives Control Act (§23-36-40) requires a permit be obtained from the State Fire Marshal for all Explosive Storage Magazines and the permit is valid for one calendar year (January 1- December 31).

For your convenience, a 2017 Magazine Application is attached. You may make additional copies of the application as required. Completed applications must be postmarked prior to the expiration date. Incomplete or inaccurate applications will be returned to the applicant and may result in your application not being postmarked by December 31, 2016. Applications not postmarked by the deadline may be subject to a late fee of \$100.00 per magazine.

Each application must include **all** of the following:

- Completed 2017 Magazine Permit Application
- Copy of applicable Federal Explosives License
- Proper application fees (Payment can be made by check payable to the “State of South Carolina” or you may also pay for the permit using Visa or MasterCard with the attached authorization form.)

Remember, the S.C. Explosives Control Act requires that a new permit must be applied for (and in place) prior to January 1 of each year. If a magazine permit has not been applied for by the expiration date, explosive storage is not permitted in the magazine. By storing explosives in an unpermitted magazine, the individual will be in violation of the Explosives Control Act and may be subject to civil penalties up to \$1,000 per violation. In appropriate cases, the individual may also be subject to criminal sanctions, including fines or imprisonment.
